

The constitution requires that I inform you of your rights. You have the right to remain silent. If you talk to any Police Officer anything you say can and will be used against you in court. You have the right to consult with a lawyer before you are questioned and have him with you during questioning. If you cannot afford a lawyer one will be appointed for you if you wish before answering any questions. If you wish to answer questions you have the right to stop at any time. You may stop answering questions any time you wish to have a lawyer with you during questioning.
