You have the right to consult with a lawyer before you are questioned and have him with you during questioning. If you cannot afford a lawyer one will be appointed for you if you wish before answering any questions. If you wish to answer questions you have the right to stop at any time. You may stop answering questions any time you wish to have a lawyer with you during questioning.

STATEMENT

I SWEAR TO DET MICHAEL MORRISSEY THAT THE STATEMENT I AM ABOUT TO GIVE IS THE TRUTH TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE.

THAT on Sunday 8-MAR-87 My Grandmother, BERNICE MARTIN, WAS KILLED in her APARTMENT located in MAYFAIR GARDENS. BECAUSE OF THAT EVENT I RECALL SPECIFICALLY WHAT HAPPENED THAT DAY. We had visited BERNICE at her APARTMENT FROM APPROXIMATELY 2:00 - 4:00 PM. AT ABOUT 4:00 PM ALL THREE OF US (My Husband Richard LaPointe and my son SEAN) left and WALKED home. The visit with My Grandmother WAS NORMAL and there was NO NOTICEABLE AGITATION OR PROBLEMS.

When we arrived home I started preparing Dinner which consisted of Meatloaf, scallop potatoes and green peas. While doing this Richard took the dog out for a walk. He went out the front door and I watched him walk up Union St past Wood Lane towards North Main St. When he usually walked the dog he would turn down Wood Lane then onto North St to Golway then back up Union St to our house. It was gone ABOUT TWENTY MINUTES. When he returned he was NOT obviously distressed and seemed to BE NORMAL.

I have read the above statement and it is the truth to the best of my knowledge. I fully understand that if I make a statement that is untrue and which is intended to mislead a law enforcement officer in the performance of his official duties I will be in violation of Section 53a-157 of the Connecticut General Statutes. A false statement is a Class A Misdemeanor punishable up to a year in jail and/or \$1000.00 fine.
